

SSR Policy

Annual Meeting Presentations

Purpose:

This policy defines the requirements for abstract acceptance and presentation at the Society Annual Meeting.

Policy:

Final acceptance of an abstract for presentation at the Annual Meeting cannot be issued until the presenter submits a completed Financial Disclosure Form and Conflict of Interest Form and all accounts receivable are current. Should a presenter not meet these requirements by the first day of January preceding the meeting, the abstract will be withdrawn.

If a presenter is unavailable on the assigned date, the Program Committee may select an alternate abstract for the final program.

Presentations at the Annual Meeting will be limited to members and fellows in MSK training programs under the direct supervision of a member. Supervising staff must be present during fellow presentations.

Guests are not eligible to present at the Society Annual Meeting.

Any variations from this policy must be approved by the Program Committee.
